

Business Recovery Center

The Business Recovery Center is an initiative by the City of Fishers to connect Fishers businesses with federal, state, and local resources to facilitate business reopening & recovery in Fishers. Businesses seeking guidance from the Recovery Center will sign up for 30-minute blocks of time to meet with a member of Fishers Economic Development team, who will then guide and connect you with the appropriate contacts and resources.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Business Recovery Center, your business must be based in Fishers. The Recovery Center is directed toward businesses of all sizes and across all industries.

Program Specifics

The Business Recovery Center provides the following:

- 1 Review of your business, prior to COVID-19, and discuss a path forward for reopening
- 2 Information from the Health Department on best practices for healthy and safe workplaces, upon reopening
- 3 Guidance on seeking and applying for potential Federal and local loan and grant programs as you approach reopening & recovery
- 4 Local resources, including but not limited to, access to the Fishers Virtual Job Fair, Nonprofit needs, Support Local Guide, and the Fishers Health Department Business Engagement Team
